## PLANNING DEPARTMENT STAFF:

Chairman Parker opened the meeting, established a quorum and conducted the consideration of the following items in the order presented. Kelly Shaw and Cris Valverde gave the recommendations for the agenda items.

- A. <u>A. Consider a recommendation of proposed Subdivision Ordinance amendments, Section 4-6-59 (d) (1) (2), regarding partial release requirements.</u>
