1. **Minutes:**
Approval of the Traffic Commission minutes of the regular meeting held on May 21, 2014.
2. **Pedestrian and Bicycle Mobility:**
Consider a review of pedestrian and bicycle mobility policies and plans adopted by the City, their applicability to the responsibilities of the Traffic Commission and any recommended additions or revisions to the same.
3. **Traffic Lane Width:**
Consider drafting a policy to present to the City Council to narrow center and through lanes to allow wider curb lanes, where practical, to make facilities more bicycle friendly. This policy would be applied to restriping projects. When applied, this policy will not allow a through or turn lane to be less than ten feet wide.
4. **Public Forum:**
Time reserved for anyone to speak on any traffic engineering related item. However, no action can be taken on items not on the Agenda.

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
