




**Seatbelt Policy**

Amarillo City Transit requires that all passengers wear a seatbelt while riding any Amarillo City Transit vehicle. This policy affects both ambulatory passengers and persons in wheelchairs.


There are two exceptions to this rule. The first exception includes infants and small children. If a person boards a bus carrying an infant or small child, they may hold the infant or child in their lap while riding the bus. The second exception applies to a person that has a letter from their doctor stating it is physically or medically detrimental for that person to use a seatbelt.

Persons who do not comply with the seatbelt policy will not be allowed to ride Amarillo City Transit Buses.
