






Designated Bus Stop Policy

Buses will pick-up and drop-off passengers at designated bus stops. All designated stops are marked by an Amarillo Transit bus stop sign.

Seatbelt Policy

Amarillo City Transit requires that all passengers wear a seatbelt while riding any Amarillo City Transit vehicle. This policy affects both ambulatory passengers and persons in wheelchairs.

There are two exceptions to this policy. The first exception includes infants or small children. If a person boards a bus carrying an infant or small child, they may hold the infant or small child in their lap while they are on the bus. The second exception would apply to a person that has a letter from a doctor stating it is physically or medically detrimental for a person to use a seatbelt.

Persons who do not comply with the seatbelt policy will not be allowed to ride Amarillo City Transit Buses.
