1. Presentation of proposed changes to Chapter 8-2 Animals and Fowl Ordinances

Director of Animal Management & Welfare or Designee will present on proposed changes to the Amarillo Municipal Code, Chapter 8-2, Animals and Fowl:

2. Public Hearing:

This is a public hearing for the proposed ordinance changes. The total time allotted for comments is 30-minutes with each speaker being limited to three (3) minutes. Amarillo Animal Management & Welfare Advisory Board may not discuss items not on this agenda.

3. Official Consideration:

The Amarillo Animal Management & Welfare Advisory Board will formally consider and take action on the proposed changes to Animal Municipal Code, Chapter 8-2, Animals and Fowl.

4. Update on Amarillo-Panhandle Humane Society’s “90-Four-90” Plan

Executive Director or designee of Amarillo-Panhandle Humane Society will present an update on the 90-Four-90 Plan to achieve a 90% Live Release Rate in Four Years.
