

RESOLUTION NO. 07-08-25-2

A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING AND FURTHER CLARIFYING RESOLUTION NO. 05-13-25-1 TO INCLUDE AND ATTACH ALL PUBLISHED VOTING TABULATIONS AND CERTIFICATES OF ELECTION RELATED TO CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS FOR THE REGULAR ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF AMARILLO ON THE 3RD DAY OF MAY, 2025 FOR CITY OFFICES; ORDERING THE RUNOFF ELECTION OF THE CITY OF AMARILLO TO BE CONDUCTED ON THE 7TH DAY OF JUNE, 2025, IN THE CITY OF AMARILLO, TEXAS; DESIGNATING POLLING PLACES; AND PROVIDING FOR THE CONDUCT OF SUCH ELECTION.

WHEREAS, on this the 13th day of May, 2025, came on to be considered by the Amarillo City Council the canvass of the returns of the City Officers Election held in the City of Amarillo on the 3rd day of May, 2025, for the purpose of electing a Mayor, Councilmember, Place No. 1; Councilmember, Place No. 2; Councilmember, Place No. 3; Councilmember, Place No. 4; and

WHEREAS, the election returns duly canvassed by Resolution No. 05-13-25-1 included and are a product of all voting tabulations showing the total votes by precinct, the early tabulations of votes reported by precinct, and all other voting information duly certified and published as required by law, the same of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes, and

WHEREAS, the Certificates of Election for the newly elected candidates as Mayor, Councilmember, Place No. 1, Councilmember, Place No. 2, Councilmember, Place No. 4 are also attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution is merely for the purpose of clarification and for further publication of voting tabulations that were not attached to Resolution No. 05-13-25-1, nor were the Certificates of Election presented, and Resolution No. 05-13-25-1, Canvassing of Returns, approved on the 13th day of May, 2025, is hereby affirmed and remains in full force; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has canvassed the returns of said election and it appears from said returns, duly and legally made, that there were 16,834 valid and legal ballots cast in said election; and that each of the candidates in said election received the following votes:

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AMARILLO, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That said election was duly called; that notice of said election was given and held in accordance with law; and that said election and the returns thereof have been duly canvassed by the City Council.

SECTION 2. That at said election:

- A. Cole Stanley received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Mayor and was duly elected Mayor of the City of Amarillo.
- B. Tim Reid received a majority of the votes cast for and was duly elected as Councilmember, Place No. 1.
- C. Don Tipps received a majority of the votes cast for and was duly elected as Councilmember, Place No. 2.
- D. No candidate received a majority of the votes cast for Councilmember, Place No. 3.
- E. Les Simpson received a majority of the votes cast for and was duly elected as Councilmember, Place No. 4.

SECTION 3. That because no candidate received a majority of all votes cast for the office(s) of Councilmember, Place 3, a runoff is hereby declared necessary and is called to be held on June 7, 2025, between the two candidates receiving the most votes for such office(s):

SECTION 6. That the City Secretary is expressly authorized to: obtain election supplies; pay election officials; contract for some or all election duties and services from Potter and Randall counties, in accordance with the adopted budget, applicable law, and the attached agreements and the City Manager is authorized to execute and perform the same.

SECTION 7. The election shall be held in each of the election precincts of each participating entity as stated herein.

SECTION 8. Electronic voting system is authorized and shall be used for voting and counting in the election, subject to the attached agreements and any contingency plan (of each county conducting a part of the City election) for problems with the electronic voting system.

SECTION 9. Early voting shall be conducted as stated herein.

Ballots shall be used for early voting by mail, and electronic or other ballot forms shall be used for casting early votes by personal appearance. The City Secretary is authorized to appoint an Early Voting Ballot Board to count and sort early votes, and other personnel for other duties, all as may be necessary or convenient in the conduct of the election or the City portion of a joint election with the other entities.

SECTION 10. That voting results of the City election from Potter and Randall County precincts shall, respectively, be completed at each County's counting station (to-wit: Potter

County, at 900 S. Polk, Suite 320, Amarillo; and Randall County, at 1604 5th Ave. Canyon, TX) and, the results promptly provided to the City Secretary or her designee.

SECTION 11. That this Resolution is for the sole purpose of clarification and further publication of the attached voting tabulations submitted by both Randall County and Potter County the same of which was canvassed by Resolution No. 05-13-25-1, and the presentation of the attached Certificates of Election for the newly elected candidates as Mayor, Councilmember, Place No. 1, Councilmember, Place No. 2, and Councilmember, Place No. 4.

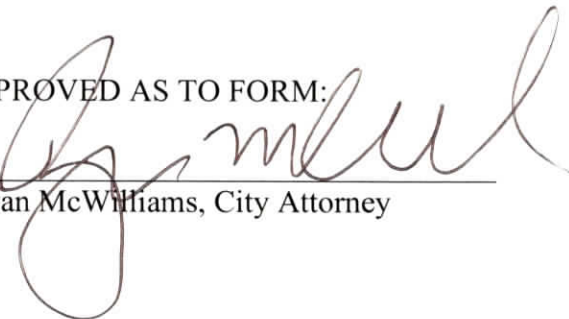
