

## Community Service Agencies List for Ages 17 and Younger

Community service hours must be performed at a nonprofit *OR* faith-based organization. All nonprofit organizations must operate under section 501(c)(3) of Title 26 of the Internal Revenue Code. This is a list of approved nonprofit organizations in Amarillo. Review the list and any restrictions that may be listed, contact the agency of your choice and complete the hours as required on the log provided. If an organization is not listed, please contact the Court at 806-378-5232 or email [courtprograms@amarillo.gov](mailto:courtprograms@amarillo.gov) to provide the agency information, a contact name and number, and proof of 501(c)(3) verification PRIOR to beginning community service hours. The Court must verify nonprofit status of any organization not listed below BEFORE community service hours will be accepted.

Please try to complete all community service hours at one location. If you go to more than one location, community service hours must be documented on a separate community service log sheet.
